# 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Banquet Monday, December 4<sup>th</sup>

The place was Washington, D.C. and the date was December 4, 1867. Seven men gathered in the office of Williams Saunders, Superintendent of the Propagating Gardens of the U.S. Department of Agriculture to form a fraternal society to aid farmers in the turbulent days following the Civil War. That fraternity would come to be known the Grange or the Order of Patrons of Husbandry.

Perry County Granges are marking this occasion with an anniversary celebration banquet exactly 150 years to the day of the order's founding. A buffet dinner will be enjoyed followed by entertainment and historical highlights of the Grange's century and a half of service.

# **Grange Continues Service to Community:**

#### Contributes Substantial Dollars to Many Civic Causes

Since selling our hall in 2014, Perry Valley Grange has continued its active service to the community. Recently, more than \$15,000 has been contributed by the Grange to support various charitable and civic causes in the area. The largest project for 2017 was the awarding of a major grant to Fort Hunter Park to underwrite the installation of eight permanent outdoor educational signs in the recently developed section of the park.

A total of eight permanent outdoor educational signs were installed with the grant to help visitors learn more about the geology of the Susquehanna River, the history of Fort Hunter and local Native Americans, stories of river commerce and the Rockville Bridge in bygone days and information about fish and birds of the Susquehanna basin. The signs may be viewed any day from dawn to dusk in the park area along the Susquehanna River between Heckton Church and the boat launch.

A second major project was the sponsorship of the Environ-Go Day in May for elementary students from Greenwood and Newport School Districts. The event, held at the Millerstown Community Park, was a day filled with educational activities for the children on various environmental topics. Other recent Grange donations purchased books and supplies for the Newport Public Library summer reading program; assisted Perry County Children & Youth to underwrite the purchase, training and maintenance of a courthouse advocacy dog; sponsored a free community concert with refreshments at the Millerstown Community Park; financed vocational education and FFA awards in two local high schools; provided emergency help for needy children and supported the work of fighting childhood hunger through the Perry County BackPack Program.

The Perry County Children K-9 Fund recently received \$750 from Perry Valley Grange to assist with the purchase, training and maintenance of a "courthouse dog" which will serve as an ambassador for child welfare in the court system. The dog will provide comfort and advocacy to children who have been physically or sexually abused when they may be called upon to testify in various legal or custody proceedings. 




