Soup Donations for Library Bike Tour

Since 2005 the Grange has made and donated homemade chicken corn soup to feed the 200+ participants in the Newport Public Library's annual bike tour, a major fund raiser supporting the local library. During the summer of 2009 the Grange pulled, husked, clean, cut and froze gallons of corn that will find its way into the soup for dozens of riders in the September 2009 bike ride. Grange volunteers made and delivered about 50 quarts of the corn soup that has become a favorite with the hungry riders.
