


Community Service Projects – Past & Future

Blankets Warm Hurricane Victims in North Carolina

(Picture on Page 8) The old adage "Many hands make light work" was never truer than on a Tuesday afternoon in October when 83 community volunteers joined efforts to make 76 tied fleece blankets for delivery to victims of recent storms that devastated parts of the southern U.S. Gathering in Millerstown's New Harvest Church, the task was completed in less than two hours in an inspiring demonstration of community spirit and generosity for those in need. Comments heard from volunteers included "It hardly seemed like work" and "We had a great time while doing a good deed for others".

Originally an idea promoted by the Perry County Pomona Grange, the proposal quickly gathered support from school and community groups, which generously provided blanket materials, recruited volunteers and donated food to provide a light supper for those who helped. Participating groups included the local Granges of the county, the Greenwood High School FFA and National Honor Society, New Harvest Church, St. John (Barner's) Lutheran Church and Hetrick Daycare. The blankets were delivered by Pete and Heather Brummer of Millerstown to residents in areas of North Carolina especially hard hit by the storms.



Suggested minimum donation of \$13 per meal is requested; proceeds support Grange sponsored community service projects




