## Child Protection Program Friday, September 11<sup>th</sup>

Many changes in the laws related to child protection clearances have recently been enacted by the state legislature to provide additional safeguards for children and youth. Perry Valley Grange has arranged a public meeting on Friday, September 11, 2015 in which State Representative Mark Keller will discuss those changes and answer questions. This informational program will begin at 6:30 p.m. in the Black Memorial Pavilion of the Millerstown Community Park,110 West Juniata Parkway, Millerstown.

The Grange will host an opening dessert reception and then Rep. Keller will review the new requirements to obtain and maintain the required clearances for persons who provide volunteer work with children and youth in our community. This program is provided as an educational service to the community and the public is urged to attend.

In the event of stormy weather, this outdoor meeting will be moved to the Millerstown Senior Center, 99 Greenwood Street.


## **Harvesting the Fun**



#### **New Service Opportunity**

A speaker at one of our Grange meetings last winter sparked some interest in the School Backpack Program. Food items packed into a child's backpack are provided on Friday as school is ending to provide much needed nutrition over the weekend when school breakfast and lunch programs are not available.

Efforts are underway to bring this program, currently operating in schools in central and western parts of the county, to the Newport and Greenwood School Districts. While the Grange has not been able to find a volunteer to head up these programs, we now have an opportunity to help. Megan Gantt, daughter of our Grange secretary and a staff member at Newport Elementary School, has agreed to chair the program in that district.

Beginning October 9<sup>th</sup>, a school service club will prepare the backpacks of food from supplies stored at the Office of the Aging. At least two volunteers will be needed at the school each Friday afternoon to help with the distribution of the backpacks to children enrolled in this program.
