APPLE DESSERT CONTEST

Friday, October 14, 2016

Participation Open to the Public

- 1. This contest, sponsored by Perry Valley Grange, is open to the community for individuals of all ages, both male and female. There are two (2) age categories of competition: **Youth** (age 18 and under) and **Adult** (over age 18). Contestants may submit more than one entry.
- 2. Entries may be any type apple dessert (not limited to pies). A typed or printed recipe must accompany each entry.
- 3. All entries must contain apples or apple by-products in the ingredients.
- 4. All entries must be brought to Millerstown Community Park Building, 110 Juniata Parkway West, Millerstown, PA between 6:00-6:30 PM on Friday, October 14, 2016.
- 5. Judging criteria will be: Taste 70%; Appearance 30%.
- 6. While judging is taking place, Patty Wertz of the PA Apple Marketing Board will present a program about Pennsylvania's \$80 million apple industry. Announcement of the dessert contest winners, presentation of awards and sampling of the tasty entries will take place during a social hour immediately following the program. Cash awards will be as follows:

Youth: First - \$25; Second - \$15; Third - \$10 Adult: First - \$25; Second - \$15; Third - \$10

- 7. Contestants agree to the publication of their recipe in local newspapers as space permits.






